xReporter is an open-source project with a very liberal license. This means a lot more than just giving the source code away for free, and you as a user sitting back and anxiously awaiting the next release. We welcome your participation, being it questions, comments, remarks, [bug reports](#)¹, documentation enhancements or feature requests.

Getting involved starts with subscribing to the xReporter mailing lists, making you part of the xReporter community. You have direct, read-only access to the evolving codebase, both through a [web interface](#)² or through direct SVN access. Do not hesitate to send in patches! Regular contributors will be granted commit access to the xReporter codebase, giving them the ability to help growing xReporter in the direction they want.

Another way of getting involved is through [funding](#)³ the development of additional features of xReporter. While we support and enhance xReporter on a continuous basis, [being paid](#)⁴ for developing xReporter surely shifts priorities.
